An object pronoun is used in place of the noun that is acted upon or that receives the action of the verb in the sentence.

Object Pronouns		
Person	Singular	Plural
1st (speaking)	me	us
2nd (spoken to)	you	you
3rd (spoken about)	him/her/it	them
