Possessive Nouns

Possessive nouns show that something belongs to a person, place, thing or idea. Add an apostrophe and an "s" to the end of a noun to make it possessive.

EXAMPLE: This desk belongs to Jane.

Jane's desk

The pencil belongs to May.

May's pencil

If the noun already ends in "s", just add an apostrophe to the end.

EXAMPLE: The paper belongs to Janis.

Janis' paper

The chair belongs to Bess .

Bess' chair
