

# Singular Subject Pronouns

A subject pronoun takes the place of a noun that is the subject of a sentence, usually after it has already been introduced.

Person	Singular Subject Pronouns
1st (speaking)	I
2nd (being spoken to)	You
3rd (being spoken about)	He/She/It
