

# Simple Subjects



The **simple subject** is a word or a group of words that tells whom or what the sentence is about. Example:

The tire seems upset.

The **complete subject** includes all the words that tell whom or what a sentence is about. Example:

The tire that is flat seems upset.

All simple subjects are complete subjects, but not all complete subjects are simple subjects. The complete subject includes extra information that tells more about the simple subject.
