# Transitive Verbs

A transitive verb is a verb that requires an object to receive its action. If you can answer the question "What?" about the verb in a sentence and find a direct object, the verb is transitive. For example:



Kimberly packed her backpack.

**ASK:** Kimberly packed what?

**ANSWER:** backpack. *Backpack* is the direct object of the transitive verb *brought*.
