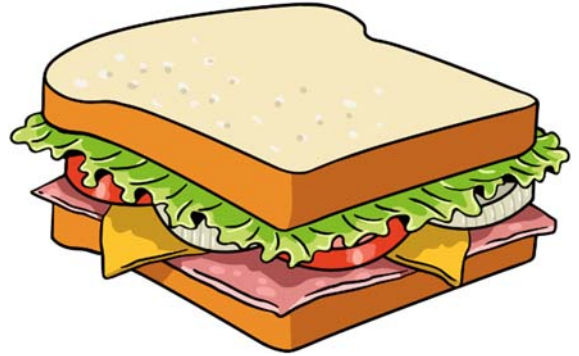

Multiplication Word Problems



1. Tommy is making sandwiches for a picnic. He needs 4 slices of bread for each sandwich, and he wants to make 3 sandwiches. How many slices of bread does Tommy need in total?
2. Emily is organizing her toy cars. She has 5 toy car collections, and each collection has 6 cars. How many toy cars does Emily have in total?
3. Lily is setting up tables for a party. She needs to set up 6 rows of tables, and each row has 7 tables. How many tables will Lily set up in total?
4. Daniel is buying snacks for a movie night. He wants to buy 3 packs of popcorn, and each pack contains 8 popcorn bags. How many popcorn bags will Daniel buy in total?
5. Sarah is packing pencils for school. She wants to pack 8 boxes of pencils, and each box contains 5 pencils. How many pencils will Sarah pack in total?
6. Tommy is counting his baseball cards. He has 4 card packs, and each pack contains 9 cards. How many baseball cards does Tommy have in total?
7. Emily is organizing her sticker collection. She has 7 sticker albums, and each album has 4 pages. How many pages of stickers does Emily have in total?
8. Lily is baking cupcakes for a bake sale. She needs 2 cups of flour for each batch of cupcakes, and she wants to make 5 batches. How many cups of flour does Lily need in total?
9. Daniel is setting up chairs for a classroom. He needs to set up 5 rows of chairs, and each row has 10 chairs. How many chairs will Daniel set up in total?
10. Sarah is buying candies for Halloween. She wants to buy 6 bags of candies, and each bag contains 10 candies. How many candies will Sarah buy in total?
