- A toothed whale famous for its long, spiral tusk that resembles a unicorn horn.
- A white whale known for its bulbous forehead, playful nature, and highly social behaviors in Arctic waters.
- Known as reindeer, are large, migratory deer adapted to cold climates with thick fur and large antlers.
- The herbivorous mammal with a thick white fur for camouflage and warmth, adapted to surviving the cold, barren tundra of the Arctic.
- Lemmings are small, herbivorous rodents that thrive in Arctic tundra and are known for their population boom-and-bust cycles.
- Seabirds with colorful beaks, skilled at diving for fish in Arctic and sub-Arctic oceans.
- Sleek marine mammals that live on ice and in the ocean, using their flippers for swimming and hauling out on land.
- Known as killer whales, are apex predators with striking black-and-white coloring, often seen hunting in Arctic waters.
