A set of horizontal lines used as a framework for writing musical symbols.

A written symbol representing the duration and frequency of a sound.

A sign indicating a period of silence in the flow of a piece.

A mark showing that a tone should be raised by a semitone.

A sign signaling that a pitch should be lowered by a semitone.

A tonal framework defined by a specific set of scales and harmonies.

The basic unit of time, often perceived as the pulse in a composition.

A division of music into equal segments, typically marked by vertical lines.

A symbol indicating that a note or rest should be prolonged at the performer's discretion.
