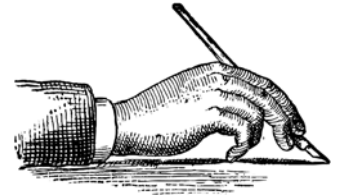

# Epizeuxis

Epizeuxis is a rhetorical device meaning the repetition of a word or phrase in rapid succession without interruption.

## EXAMPLE:

He's guilty! Guilty! Guilty, I tell you!

The purpose of epizeuxis is to stress or emphasize the repeated word or phrase.
