



ANSWERS

Prologue

a short introductory section in a novel that sets the stage for what is to come in the story

appears only before the main body of the text

provides important background information that effects the reader's ability to fully understand the events of the story

Appear in works of fiction

Not every novel has one

a prologue usually requires exposition later in the story

It is fiction

Both Prologue and Preface

both provide contextual information

both clarify things for the reader

both are written by the author

Both appear at the beginning of a book

Preface

an introduction to a book or other literary work by the author

the preface itself is non fiction

a preface can appear in fiction or nonfiction, but it rarely occurs in fiction
