



Mesodiplosis

Mesodiplosis is the repetition of a word or phrase in the middle of each phrase or clause.

EXAMPLE:

She is frank **but not** honest; efficient **but not** kind; quick **but not** thorough.

The purpose of mesodiplosis, like all repetition, is to stress or emphasize the repeated word or phrase.
