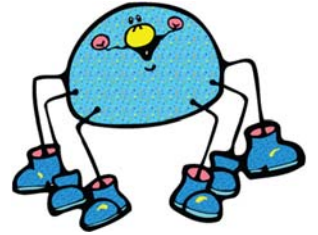


Transitive Verbs



A **transitive verb** is an action verb that has a direct object. You can think of it as a transitive verb *transferring* its action to the direct object. An **intransitive verb** is an action verb that does not have a direct object. Usually, any information that follows an intransitive verb Any information that follows an intransitive verb is usually in the form of an adverbial phrase.

Intransitive Verb: The spider stretched.

Transitive Verb: The spider stretched its legs.
