single quotes

to replace double quotation marks inside of other quotation marks.

double quotes

- to indicate a direct quote
- to indicate dialogue or spoken speech
- to indicate the titles of short works, like poems or songs
- To set a word apart for emphasis, for example, to signal irony, sarcasm, or skepticism
- to differentiate between a legal, given name and a nickname

In British English, the usage of the type of quotation marks is reversed.
