Rhyming Magic

Because of the rhyming and rhythm, *The Lorax* is a book that people remember long after they read it. The fun sounds of the words make the story enjoyable, while the message stays in readers' minds. Dr. Seuss knew that teaching an important lesson didn't have to be boring.
