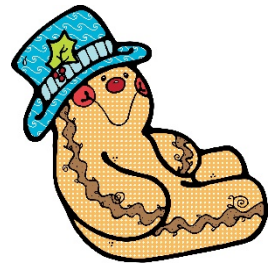


# Possessive Pronouns

his	hers	yours	mine
ours	its	theirs
