- A sturdy, recyclable material made from paper pulp, frequently used for packaging and shipping, which can be reused or recycled into new paper products.
- The practice of decreasing the overall consumption of materials and energy to minimize waste and environmental impact.
- A versatile material made from wood fibers, commonly used for printing, packaging, and other products, which can be recycled into new sheets for various uses.
- The act of finding new uses for an item, extending its life cycle by transforming it into something functional rather than discarding it.
