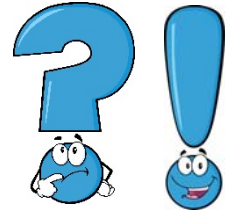

Interrobang

The interrobang is a punctuation mark (‽) used to show that a question has been expressed as an exclamation. It combines the question mark and the exclamation mark into a single punctuation mark. A sentence punctuated with an interrobang is a question that also conveys surprise and /or disbelief. The interrobang can also be communicated by pairing a question mark and an exclamation mark at the end of a sentence: !? or ?!
