Definition: A rebus uses the arrangement of pictures, letters, or symbols to represent words or phrases.

Part of Speech: It is a noun.

Usage: Rebuses were used during the Middle Ages to symbolize their family names or crests. Today, rebuses are typically found in the forms of brain-teasing puzzles.

Root: The word rebus comes from the Latin phrase *nōn verbīs sed rebus*, which means “not by words but by things.”
