4. At the cafeteria, there are 5 sandwiches on one tray and 4 burgers on another tray. How many food items are there in total?
5. Emily has 6 pink beads and 5 blue beads. How many beads does Emily have in all?
6. Johnny has 7 basketball cards, and his friend gives him 3 more. How many basketball cards does Johnny have in total?
7. There are 8 green apples and 2 red apples in a basket. How many apples are there altogether?
8. Sarah has 6 pencils, and then she finds 4 more in her drawer. How many pencils does Sarah have now?
9. Timmy has 9 toy blocks, and his brother gives him 2 more to play with. How many toy blocks does Timmy have in total?
10. At the zoo, there are 5 lions in one enclosure and 6 elephants in another. How many animals are there in total?
