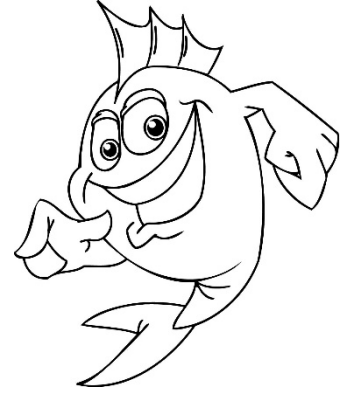


Puns

Making a pun means using a word with the intention that it be understood in more than one way. Sometimes puns are created by replacing a word with a similar sounding word. Puns can be both intentional and unintentional. They are often intended as a joke, but a pun doesn't have to be funny. For example:



- Time flies like an arrow; fruit flies like a pear.
- My favorite musician in the underwater band plays the bass.
