Verb + Gerund

A gerund is the -ing form of a verb that is used as a noun. The gerund is formed by adding the suffix “-ing” to a verb. Gerunds are used as the objects of certain verbs, such as the following:

quit/give up	mind	consider/think about
appreciate	finish	miss
avoid	mention	keep/keep on
postpone/put off	enjoy	stop
delay	suggest	discuss
