# Singular Object Pronouns

An object pronoun takes the place of a person or thing that is acted upon or that receives the action of the verb in the sentence.

Person	Singular Object Pronouns
1st (speaking)	me
2nd (being spoken to)	you
3rd (being spoken about)	him/her/it
