2. Emily is making sandwiches for a picnic. She needs 6 slices of bread for each sandwich, and she wants to make 4 sandwiches. How many slices of bread does Emily need in total?
3. Lily is organizing her toy cars. She has 4 toy car collections, and each collection has 7 cars. How many toy cars does Lily have in total?
4. Daniel is buying snacks for a party. He wants to buy 3 packs of chips, and each pack contains 10 chips. How many chips will Daniel buy in total?
5. Sarah is decorating her room. She wants to hang 6 picture frames on the wall, and each frame requires 9 nails. How many nails does Sarah need in total?
6. Chris is building a LEGO castle. He needs 8 LEGO bricks for each tower, and he wants to build 5 towers. How many LEGO bricks will Chris need in total?
7. Emily is counting her stickers. She has 6 sticker sheets, and each sheet has 5 stickers. How many stickers does Emily have in total?
8. Lily is setting up tables for a party. She needs to set up 4 rows of tables, and each row has 6 tables. How many tables will Lily set up in total?
9. Daniel is organizing his baseball cards. He has 5 card packs, and each pack contains 9 cards. How many baseball cards does Daniel have in total?
10. Sarah is packing crayons for school. She wants to pack 7 boxes of crayons, and each box contains 8 crayons. How many crayons will Sarah pack in total?
