

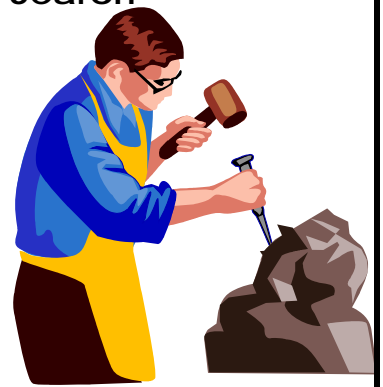

A technique where liquid material is poured into a form and allowed to harden into a specific shape.

A subtractive process involving the removal of material to reveal a desired form.

A sculptural style where figures are raised above or recessed into a flat background.

A three-dimensional representation of a figure or subject, often lifelike in form.

An internal framework providing support and structure for a piece during creation.
