The clownfish is an orange and white fish that lives in **coral** reefs. There, clownfish **have** a special relationship with **an** underwater plants called anemones. The anemone **attaches** itself to a rock or coral. It has many poisonous tentacles to protect itself from predators. The clownfish doesn't get hurt because **it's** covered with a layer of mucus which protects it. The **anemone** provides shelter for the clownfish, and the clownfish eats parasites that would otherwise make the anemone sick.
