satire

Satire is a genre that holds the vices, follies, abuses, and shortcomings of individuals or societies up to ridicule. Writers sometimes use satire to try to shame or embarrass people, organizations, governments, or society into improving.

dystopia

A dystopia is an imaginary society in which there are very unpleasant or bad things happening, even though at first glance the society looks like a very good place to live. Dystopias are a sub-genre of science fiction. The purpose of dystopian fiction is social commentary/criticism; dystopias typically call attention to something in society which could be dangerous or have negative consequences if taken to the extreme.

parody

Parody mimics a subject directly; the aim of parody is comic effect; can be an element of satire
