



# Parts of a Book

<p>On a book's <b>title page</b> you will find the name of the book, the name of the author, and the name of the company that published it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NEW THINGS</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">by George Mason</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Wisdom House</p>
<p>In the front of the book is a section called the <b>Table of Contents</b>. This tells you what is in the book and the page numbers where you can find each chapter or section.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Table of Contents</b></p> <p>First Days.....1</p> <p>New Friends .....33</p> <p>New Jobs.....83</p>
<p>Some nonfiction books have a section in the back called the <b>index</b>. The index lists the different topics in the book in alphabetical order along with the numbers of the pages on which each topic is discussed.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Index</b></p> <p>attitude, 63</p> <p>boredom, 39</p> <p>groups, 41</p> <p>jobs, 95</p> <p>students, 10, 43, 57</p>
