



Conditional Type 1

A conditional sentence expresses that one thing is dependent on something else. There are several types of conditional sentences. A Conditional Type 1 sentence describes a possible condition and its probable result. It is formed by combining an "if" clause with a main clause.

Type	Verb Tense of the "if" Clause	Verb Tense of the Main Clause
One	Simple present	Simple future

Example: If I work hard, I will accomplish my dreams.
