A quantifier is a determiner that tells how much or how many of something you have. To choose the correct quantifier, determine whether you want to modify a count noun or a non-count noun.

Quantifiers for Count Nouns	Quantifiers for Non-Count Nouns

several	a bit
a number	a good deal
a couple	no
