Go + Gerund

A gerund is the -ing form of a verb that is used as a noun. The gerund is formed by adding the suffix “-ing” to a verb. Gerunds are used as the objects of certain verbs. Go is followed by a gerund in some idiomatic expressions, typically to express recreational activities.
