



# Will vs. Would

## WILL

- *Will* is used when you are volunteering to do something in the future or when you are deciding at the time of speaking to do *something* in the future.

The negative of *will* is *will not* or the contraction *won't*.

## WOULD

- *Would* functions as the past tense of *will*
- *It* functions as the conditional mood of *will*
- *It* is used to be polite.

The negative of *would* is *would not* or the contraction *wouldn't*.
