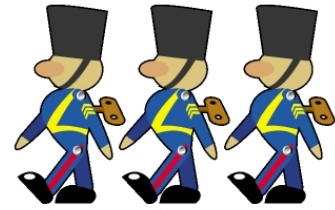

# Linking Verbs

**Linking verbs** connect a subject to its predicate without expressing **any action**. The word, phrase, or clause which follows a **linking verb** to re-identify or describe the subject is called the subject complement.
