Lens - A component made of glass or plastic that directs and concentrates light onto the recording medium.

Aperture - An adjustable opening that controls the amount of light entering the camera.

Exposure - The duration and intensity of light allowed to reach the recording medium during a shot.

Shutter - A mechanical or electronic device that opens and closes to regulate light entry for capturing an image.

Tripod - A three-legged stand used to stabilize the camera for sharper images and consistent framing.

Focus - The sharpness or clarity of the subject in an image, achieved by adjusting the optics.

Frame - The boundaries of the visible area in a photograph, determining the composition.

Lighting - The arrangement or quality of illumination used to enhance the subject or mood of an image.

Negative - A reversed tone or color image used to produce positive prints in traditional photography.

Grain - The visible texture or pattern resulting from the size of light-sensitive particles in film photography.
