1. A subject pronoun takes the place of a noun that is the subject of a sentence, usually after it has already been introduced.
2. The singular subject pronouns are: I, you, he, she, it
3. An object pronoun takes the place of a person or thing that is acted upon or that receives the action of the verb in the sentence.
4. The singular object pronouns are: me, you, him, her, it
