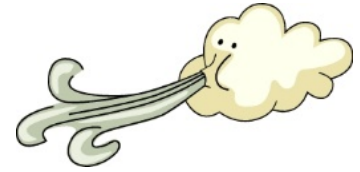


Adages and Proverbs
