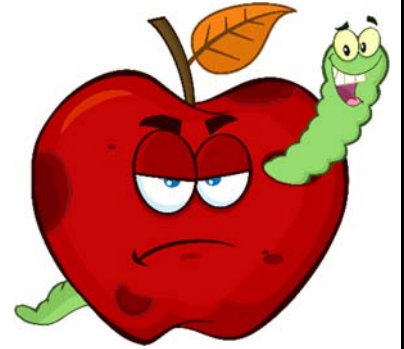

3. Tommy has 9 marbles, and then he finds 2 more on the playground. How many marbles does Tommy have in all?
4. At the pet store, there are 8 rabbits in one cage and 4 guinea pigs in another. How many small animals are there in total?
5. Sally has 5 stickers, and her friend Emily gives her 6 more. How many stickers does Sally have now?
6. Johnny has 7 toy cars, and his sister gives him 3 more. How many toy cars does Johnny have in total?
7. There are 6 blue balloons and 4 yellow balloons at the party. How many balloons are there altogether?
8. Sarah has 8 books on her shelf, and then she buys 5 more at the bookstore. How many books does Sarah have now?
9. Timmy has 9 candies, and his mom gives him 2 more as a treat. How many candies does Timmy have in total?
10. At the zoo, there are 5 monkeys in one enclosure and 6 parrots in another. How many birds and mammals are there in total?
