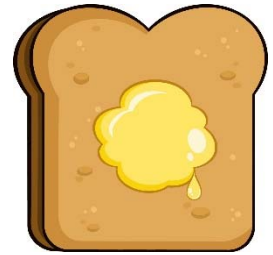


Name _____ **Limerick**

Limerick

A **limerick** is a funny, 5-line poem with a bouncy rhythm. Lines 1, 2, and 5 rhyme, and lines 3 and 4 rhyme. The rhyme scheme is AABBA. Read this example by Edward Lear:

There was an Old Man of the coast,
Who placidly sat on a post;
But when it was cold
He relinquished his hold,
And called for some hot buttered toast.
