



ANSWERS

1. binding the blank leaf or leaves following the front endpaper
2. spine the outer covering of a book
3. flyleaf a paper cover that wraps around a hardcover book
4. endpaper A page in the front of the book that tells the title, the author, and the publisher
5. book cover pages inside the cover that protect the interior of the book
6. jacket material that typically appears at the front of a book.
7. recto the righthand page inside a book
8. verso the lefthand page inside a book
9. title page the material used to make the front and back covers
10. front matter the binding joining the front and back covers where the pages hinge
