Hubris is too much pride, characterized by stubbornness and a bad attitude (you can't tell me what to do, etc.).

Pride is the satisfaction and pleasure that one feels about one's achievements, or the achievements of a friend or loved one.

Pride is characterized by good feelings and can be a source of unity (national pride, community pride, school pride, etc.)

Arrogance: Where hubris and pride are both focused on oneself and one's ability to do something, arrogance is about how one presents oneself and is perceived by others.
