Prologue

a short introductory section in a novel that sets the stage for what is to come in the story

A prologue is placed at the beginning of the book, before the main story.

Provides important background information that effects the reader's ability to fully understand the events of the story

Not every novel has one
a prologue usually requires exposition later in the story

Both Prologue and Epilogue

both are relatively short

both contain information that is supplemental to the main story

Epilogue

An epilogue is a concluding section of a story or play that provides closure or ties up loose ends.

An epilogue is placed after the main body of the story.
