



ANSWERS

1. Repetition is repeating particular words and phrases for emphasis, rhythm, etc.
2. Repetition should be used sparingly and with specific intent to add emphasis to specific ideas in a way that makes them memorable.
3. Repetition should not be used without a very specific effect in mind; repetition that is not done correctly is simply redundancy and can make your writing unclear rather than strong and emphatic.
4. Repetition of words, phrases, lines, consonant sounds, vowel sounds, as well as literary devices such as Anaphora, Epizeuxis, Mesodiplosis, Epistrophe
