# Auxiliary Verbs

<b>forms of be</b>	am, is, are, was, were, be, being, been
<b>forms of do</b>	do, does did
<b>forms of have</b>	have, has, had
<b>other auxiliary verbs</b>	can, could, may, might, must, shall, should, will, would

## Tips:

- Helping verbs and main verbs can be separated by other words (Example: *I do not need help.*)
- Some auxiliary verbs can also be used as main verbs (Example: *I am a student.*)
- A auxiliary verb can become part of a contraction with a pronoun or a negative word (Example: *I'm leaving this here.*)
