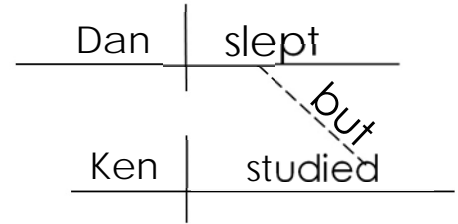




Compound Sentences
