2. Sarah picked 63 tomatoes from her garden. If she wants to divide them equally into 7 baskets, how many tomatoes will be in each basket?
3. Ethan has 36 toy cars. If he wants to share them equally among 4 shelves, how many cars will be on each shelf?
4. At the party, there are 56 slices of pizza. If they are divided equally among 8 children, how many slices will each child get?
5. In a classroom, there are 45 pencils. If they are distributed equally among 5 students, how many pencils will each student receive?
6. Farmer Joe has 64 eggs. If he wants to pack them equally into 8 cartons, how many eggs will be in each carton?
7. There are 60 books at the fair. If they are shared equally among 6 bookshelves, how many books will be on each shelf?
8. There are 56 oranges for the soccer team. If they are distributed equally among 7 players, how many oranges will each player get?
9. There are 48 fish in a tank. If they are divided equally among 6 bowls, how many fish will be in each bowl?
10. James has 80 candies. If he wants to share them equally among 10 friends, how many candies will each friend receive?
