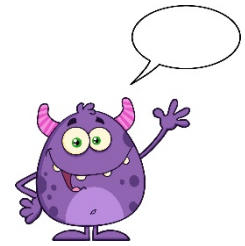

Monologue

A monologue is speech made by one character to other characters in a literary or dramatic work. The word monologue comes from Greek words meanings "to speak" and "alone." The function of monologue is to share a character's internal thoughts with the reader or the audience in order to share their motivations. A monologue is similar to a soliloquy, but in a monologue, one character is talking to other characters; a character delivering a soliloquy is talking to themselves.
