Open Ended Key

1. Capybaras stay safe from predators by diving into water and using their swimming skills. They also rely on their group for protection.
2. A capybara's body is covered with fur to stay dry, has webbed feet for swimming, and eyes, ears, and a nose on the top of its head for seeing and breathing while in water.
3. Capybaras are often called gentle animals because they are calm, friendly, and get along well with other animals and humans.
