## What's on the Menu for Angelfish?

### Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Angelfish adapt to their surroundings by eating whatever food is available, which helps them survive in different habitats.
2. (Example response) If I were an angelfish in a coral reef, I would swim close to the coral and poke my nose into small spaces to find sponges or plankton.
3. If their food sources disappeared, angelfish might struggle to survive, and their populations could shrink. This would affect the balance of their ecosystems.
4. Angelfish eat algae and small creatures, which keeps their ecosystems clean and balanced. For example, eating algae prevents it from overgrowing.
