1. Being diurnal means that angelfish are active during the day and rest at night.
2. Freshwater angelfish typically rest among plants or near rocks at night to stay hidden.
3. Freshwater angelfish live in groups called schools, while saltwater angelfish are often more territorial and live alone or in pairs.
4. Angelfish help their ecosystems by eating algae and small creatures, which keeps the environment balanced.
5. Angelfish use fin movements and changes in swimming patterns to communicate, such as signaling danger or warning others to stay away.
