The Life Cycle of an Angelfish

Short Answer Key

1. It takes two to three days for angelfish eggs to hatch.
2. During the larval stage, baby angelfish are called fry.
3. During the juvenile stage, angelfish grow larger, develop their fins, and begin to show their colors and patterns.
4. Angelfish parents care for their eggs by fanning them with their fins to provide oxygen and keeping predators away.
5. Angelfish typically live for 5 to 10 years in the wild.
