Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. (Example response) Climate change is a big problem for angelfish because it damages coral reefs, which are their homes and provide food and shelter. Without coral reefs, many saltwater angelfish could struggle to survive.
2. (Example response) People can protect angelfish habitats by reducing pollution, keeping oceans clean, and taking action to slow down climate change. Protecting coral reefs and rivers is very important.
3. (Example response) Angelfish stay safe in the wild by camouflaging with their surroundings, swimming in schools to avoid predators, and staying healthy by eating algae and small creatures.
